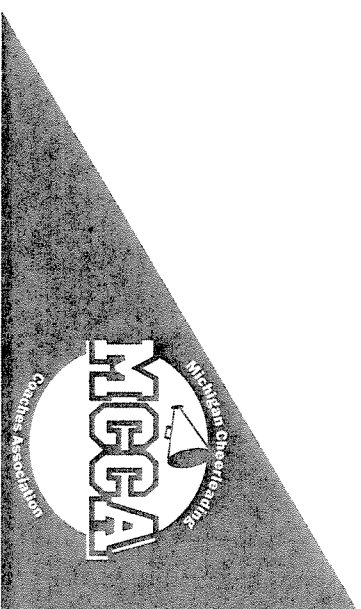

- **All-Star State Championship:** A Michigan only State Championship for all-star teams.

- **Blue and Green Competitive Scrimmage:** A early season Competitive Cheer scrimmage that offers teams and coaches the opportunity to receive mentorship, judges comments and expert commentary on your teams performances that day.
- **Fall Championship:** this competition is a sideline team format. Consisting of cheer, cheer/music and stunt divisions. Jr. High, Freshmen, J.V. and Varsity teams are invited to participate.
- **Fall Clinic for Cheerleaders:** MCCA offers an intense day of learning and fun. Cheers, chants, dance and stunts and pyramids are taught by professionals in the cheerleading community.
- **Fall Conference:** an educational weekend designed to meet the needs of coaches of teams who compete and provide training for judges.
- **GCC:** Competitive Cheer competition for both new and established teams.
- **Leadership Conference:** A conference dedicated to the coaches of tomorrow.
- **Newsletters:** distributed quarterly, offers articles and updates on what's happening in cheerleading throughout the state and nation.
- **Regional Membership Forum:** an open forum where members have the opportunity to network, ask questions and learn more about the programs and operations of MCCA. Meetings are held at the Fall and Spring Conferences.
